



PROPOSITION 39 CHARTER SCHOOL CO-LOCATIONS



PROP 39 REGULATORY TIMELINE

Prior to Proposition 39, school districts were only required to provide charter schools with surplus space (i.e., facilities not being used by the school district for instructional or administrative purposes).

In November 2000, California voters approved Proposition 39, which amended California Education Code Section 47614. School districts must now provide "reasonably equivalent" facilities to accommodate all of the charter school's students who would otherwise attend district schools.

Amended California Education Code Section 47614

"The intent of the people in amending Section 47614 is that public school facilities should be shared fairly among all public school pupils, including those in charter schools."
