Tuesday: Rally to Support Deasy, Student-Centered Policies

Hundreds of Teachers, Parents, Civic Leaders, Civil Rights Groups Will Demand Collaboration From the School Board

WHO: Hundreds of people representing a broad coalition led by CLASS, including former LAUSD board members Yolie Flores and Caprice Young.

WHAT: Amidst reports of Supt. John Deasy's possible resignation, the group will urge the school board to not only work collaboratively with Deasy, but also to continue to advance the student-centered policies supported by Deasy and the community.

WHEN: Tuesday, Oct. 29th, 11am – Noon.

WHERE: LAUSD headquarters, 333 S. Beaudry, LA CA 90017

BACKGROUND: Deasy's reported resignation has galvanized the largest and most diverse education coalition in recent memory in Los Angeles. Groups ranging from Teach for America to the L.A. Urban League, from the California Endowment to United Way of Greater Los Angeles, will rally outside the school district's downtown headquarters to call for an end to the politics that are obstructing both Supt. Deasy and policies of educational justice and equity that students deserve.
